

ACE Internationalization LAB (Selection by Invitation)

- Ultimate Strategic Purpose/Goal:
- To facilitate Comprehensive Internationalization of institutions ---internationalize teaching, research, learning and service to attain educational excellence;
- Goal for ASU Survey campus and Develop/Update Comprehensive Internationalization Plan
- Infuse international and intercultural learning into
 - curriculum and co-curriculum to ensure graduation of globally diverse society Offer Quality Education to increased enrollment, retention, and graduation rate

ACE-Process and Outcomes

- 1. ASU forms an internationalization leadership team
- 2. ASU Reviews 6 Comprehensive Internationalization Focus Areas
- **3. ASU Analyzes findings of review**
- 4. ASU develops/updates a strategic plan, analyzing the state of internationalization on campus and recommending internationalization goals and means to achieve them.
- 5. ACE conducts a site visit to ASU -meet leadership team (Nov. 2019)
- 6. ASU Reps. participates in three one-day meeting (August, 2018;



- Feb.2019; Dec., 2019)
- 7. ACE peer review team(3members) visit to ASU for 2 days(April 2020)
- 8. ACE maintains regular monthly contact with ASU
- 9. ASU dedicates sufficient staff time to accomplish review and outcomes to facilitate ASU Strategic Plan

V.P.s, Deans, Chairs, Directors' Roles – Actions Process

Faculty and staff roles
