



2023-2024 FEDERAL TEACH GRANT APPLICATION

Important: TEACH Grants will be awarded to eligible students for the 2023-2024 school year. Eligibility and award is based on term enrollment. Students will be reviewed every term to ensure GPA and program eligibility. This form must be received in our office at least 30 days prior to your last date of enrollment during the **2023-2024** academic year.

Directions: Complete this form to be considered for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. The TEACH Grant provides up to \$4,000 per year (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate programs and \$8,000 total for graduate programs) in grants to students who commit to:

1. Teach full-time;
2. Teach in high-need subject areas;
3. Teach for at least four out of the first eight years teaching at a school serving low-income students;
4. Teach at schools that serve students from low-income families.

If the commitment is not fulfilled, the grant is permanently converted to a loan to be repaid by the recipient. The loan is a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.

- If I am a first-time student to ASU, I scored above the 75th percentile on my SAT, ACT, or GRE test scores; (Attach copy of your actual test scores to this application-your application is considered incomplete without these attached)
- I have attended ASU for at least one semester and have received and/or maintained a cumulative financial aid GPA of at least 3.25.

Section C. Student Certification

I understand that the TEACH Grant program has specific service obligations that must be met in order for the award to remain as a grant. If I fail to meet all of the conditions of the award or, if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will permanently convert to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan and that I will be responsible to repay this loan with interest calculated from the first disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan; it cannot be converted back to a grant.
